PERSPECTIVE OF THE SUNDAY READINGS

"Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem... As they were about to depart from him, Peter said to Jesus, 'Master, it is good that we are here.'"

How privileged for us to join the three apostles and two prophets, on that holy mountain. Peter spoke for us, and the father spoke for His Son. Moses and Elijah represented the Old Testament, the law and the prophets, and Jesus brings what was spoken to fulfillment. For this reason, Lent becomes our retreat to join in prayer and preparation for the Paschal Mystery.

If you were on that mountain what would you say to Jesus? As you listen to God speak, what is God asking you to do as you live this special season?

“Jesús tomó a Pedro, Juan y Santiago, y subió a la montaña para orar. Mientras oraba, su rostro cambió de aspecto y sus vestiduras se volvieron de una blancura deslumbrante. Y dos hombres conversaban con él: eran Moisés y Elías, que aparecían revestidos de gloria y hablaban de la partida de Jesús, que iba a cumplirse en Jerusalén. Mientras estos se alejaban, Pedro dijo a Jesús: ‘¡Maestro, ¡qué bien estamos aquí!’”
